**Storm Warning Procedures** – this is an extract from the fixture book.  
**Please read these carefully with your parents and ensure that they are fully understood.**

**EMERGENCY PROCEDURES**

When play is suspended because of a dangerous situation such as a thunderstorm, players should discontinue play immediately and seek safe shelter.

**On no account must you**

- Stand under any overhead power lines
- Shelter under trees
- Walk under trees or on high ground if this can be avoided
- Use a mobile telephone
- Put up your umbrella

Always try to keep as low as possible and in emergencies crouch down in the nearest bunker without your umbrella and clubs.

Care must always be taken to avoid causing accidents, which can cause injury to yourself as well as other people on the course.

Remember the ground becomes slippery when it rains. Take extra care when using steps, particularly around tees.

All accidents must be reported to a competition official.

**Suspension of play will be signalled by  
A PROLONGED BLAST ON THE AIR HORN**

Depending on the situation, players will either

- (a) Be notified to resume play by – TWO BLASTS ON THE AIR HORN  
or**
- (b) Should the Committee decide to abandon play, THE AIRHORN  
WILL SOUND 5 TIMES**
