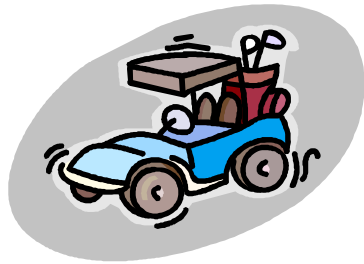

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**INSURANCE:**

For the protection of all our visitors, the Club has initiated a 50p public liability cover to ensure that all persons using the course have Public Liability Cover (including member to Member Liability) of up to £5,000,000. In this day and age we consider this a desirable protection to be provided for our visitors so that they have no qualms concerning possible accidents whilst at Cosby. We trust you fully appreciate and endorse the thought behind the scheme

**SECURITY:**

Unfortunately, thefts are common from car parks and locker rooms at golf clubs and Cosby is no exception. Individuals should take sensible precautions against theft, etc. Valuables should be removed from cars or at least kept out of sight. Small lockers are available for daily hire—these are suitable for valuables, such as wallets and ideal to share.

**DRESS:**

Visitors are asked to conform to the standards expect of members.

**Dress Not Permitted on the Course/In the Clubhouse**

Jeans, Trainers. Gents collarless shirts (both round and Vneck): football shirts and shell suits: Non-tailored shorts: Shirts must be tucked into trousers/shorts. Golf shoes may not be worn in the clubhouse (other than the locker rooms). When wearing shorts, either knee length socks or white sports socks must be worn. In addition to the above our visiting Societies are asked to change into collar & tie when dining in the evening. Ladies are asked to change from the clothes in which they played golf. We look to your support in this matter.

**HANDICAPS:**

All visitors should be in possession of an official Club/EGU/Society Handicap.

**ETIQUETTE:**

All visitors are expected to observe the etiquette of the game of golf.

**TEES:**

All members of the visiting Society must start from the 1st tee, unless agreed in advance with the Manager.

Yellow markers (gents) Red Markers (Ladies) are to be used Organisers are to ensure that the times allocated are adhered to Texas Scrambles are unfortunately not allowed.

For 4 Ball matches please allow 8 minute intervals

For 3 Ball matches please allow 7 minute intervals

**CATERING:**

All catering requirements must be arranged with David Flannagan, the Catering Manager, direct on 0116 2864759 (option 4)

Similarly, all bar requirements must be arranged with the Bar Manager, Paul Foulkes on 0116 2864759 (option 3). No outside catering or bar facilities are permitted.

**ADMINISTRATION:**

Numbers must be confirmed no less than 7 days prior to the visit.

The Society Organiser is requested to supply the office with:-

- the names of those taking part
- Confirmation that all members possess a valid handicap
- Confirmation that the appropriate arrangements for bar, catering and prizes have been made

**PAYMENT:**

All fees should be paid in cash/cheques on the day in the office. For 2009 it will be possible to pay for your Society package by credit card or visa, in addition to cheque and cash.
